

MINUTES OF THE LEE COUNTY COMMISSION, REGULAR TERM, FEB. 25, 2026

The Lee County Commission convened in regular session at the Courthouse in Opelika, Alabama, on Wednesday, Feb. 25, 2026, at 5:00 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited, followed by the invocation by Commissioner Cannon.

Chairman Judge Jere Colley declared a quorum and officially opened the meeting with the following members recorded as being present: Commissioners Doug Cannon, Ross Morris, Jeff Drury, Tony Langley, and Richard LaGrand.

Lance Farrar presented his ideas to address the solid waste issue as well as state his concerns over the status of his public records requests.

Judy Lockhart thanked the Highway Department for cleaning up the trash along Lee Road 188, Commissioner LaGrand for his support of Loachapoka High School and Sheriff Jones for addressing traffic concerns at the school. She also asked for Day Lily Street to have improved maintenance.

John Sophocleus requested a copy of his solid waste contract as well as discussed concerns with the solid waste situation.

Harold Whatley encouraged the Commission to consider their employees and the citizens of the County as they make decisions that affect them.

Gloria Owens from the James Owens Foundation thanked Commissioner LaGrand for an appropriation to the foundation to help fund scholarships at Loachapoka, Beauregard, Beulah and Smiths Station High Schools.

Judge Colley recognized the elected officials in attendance: Sheriff Jay Jones. News media in attendance included: Alex Husting with the Opelika-Auburn News and Hannah Goldfinger with the Opelika Observer.

Student-athletes from the Beauregard High School wrestling team were recognized for their recent accomplishments. Commissioner Langley introduced Assistant Varsity Coach Kelly Tubbs and recognized Eighth grader Gaven Jordan - 106-lb division; Senior Parker Van Noy - 113-lb division, three-time State Qualifier, 1st at Sectionals two years in a row, and second State Championship; Junior Barrett Bowling - 132-lb division, 2nd place at Sectionals; Senior Kole Baldwin- 175-lb division, 1st place at Sectionals. Recognized on the Girls side were: Senior Sadirah White - 114-lb division, two-time State Qualifier; and Senior Mattie Brown - 152-lb division, 2nd at Sectionals and a two-time State Qualifier. Not able to be present were: Head Coach Wade Thorn; Head Girl's Coach Kathy Brown; Assistant Head Coach Jill Thorn; Seventh grader Barrett Bowling – 120-lb division, 2nd place Sectionals finish; and Senior Brody Edwards – 138-lb division, five-time State Qualifier, 1st at Sectionals two years in a row, and State Runner Up.

Pamela Hughes, Executive Director of MidSouth RC&D, presented information on the

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Council's upcoming grant cycle which will run from April 1 - June 30. She stated Lee County organizations submitted more grant applications during the previous cycle than ever before and thanked board members Commissioners Cannon and Morris for their leadership.

Marilyn Bopp, Mercy Medical Director of Development, presented an update regarding its new building. She stated they had received \$150,000 from the City of Auburn and \$100,000 from the City of Opelika, but were lacking \$1.2 million; any support from the Commission would be appreciated. She also invited the Commissioners to the new building's ribbon cutting at 11:30 a.m. on Feb. 26.

Wade Bennett, with Leadership Lee County, presented the 2025-226 class initiative, Project Mustard Seed. The group requested Commission support for the project, which will be a multiphase project at the Community Market. See attachment.

Commissioner Morris invited everyone to attend the unveiling of the new Courthouse Historical Marker on Sunday, March 1, at 2 p.m.

Copies of the items on the Consent Agenda sent to the Commissioners in their packets included: listings of claims to be approved and ratified, procurement card transactions listing, and a copy of the minutes from Feb. 9, 2026. In addition, the first reading of Randy Mauldin to the Smiths Station Fire Protection District was held. Commissioner Cannon made a motion, seconded by Commissioner LaGrand to approve the consent agenda. The motion carried unanimously. See attachment.

There were no items of Old Business.

Sheriff Jones presented an ABC License application for 040 Retail Beer (On or Off-Premises) 060 Retail Table Wine (On or Off-Premises Only) and 990 Tobacco and Alternative Nicotine Products for Byrons Smokehouse at University Station located in District 1. Sheriff Jones stated there were no objections to the license. Commissioner Cannon made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Morris, to approve the following Resolution for issuance of the licenses to Byrons Smokehouse at University Station. The motion passed unanimously. See attachment.

BE IT RESOLVED, the Lee County Commission hereby approves the applications for a 040 Retail Beer (On or Off-Premises) 060 Retail Table Wine (On or Off-Premises Only) and 990 Tobacco and Alternative Nicotine Products for Byrons Smokehouse at University Station located at 3050 AL Hwy 14 West, Auburn, Alabama.

Judge Colley presented a request to change two polling places due to unexpected emergent issues. The polling places to be changed include Beat 1 from Beulah High School to Beulah Baptist Church due to high school graduation; and Beat 6, Box 7 from All Christ Church (formerly Auburn Community Church) to Lake Wilmore Recreation Park due to school-related concerns. Commissioner Morris made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Langley, to approve the polling place location change request. The motion carried unanimously. See attachment.

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Chief Operations Officer Blake Beck presented two change orders for the T.K. Davis Justice Center Project. He stated the change orders (\$138,610.29 and \$58,916.59) should be the last change orders for the project which has an estimated completion date of October. Commissioner Cannon made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Morris, to approve the change order request. The motion carried unanimously. See attachment.

Assistant County Engineer Patrick Harvill presented a request to accept Deerfield Oaks Subdivision for maintenance. With the required two (2) year maintenance period and greater than 70 percent of home construction requirements having been met, Mr. Harvill requested Lee Roads 2228 and 2229 be accepted for permanent maintenance by the Highway Department. Commissioner LaGrand made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Langley, to accept the Deerfield Oaks Subdivision Lee Roads 2228 and 2229 for maintenance. The motion carried unanimously. See attachment.

At approximately 5:48 p.m., Commissioner Cannon made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Langley, to adjourn. The motion carried unanimously.

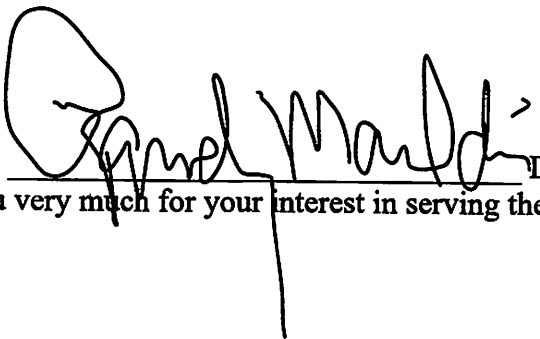

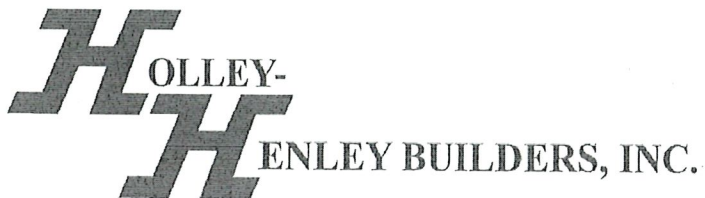

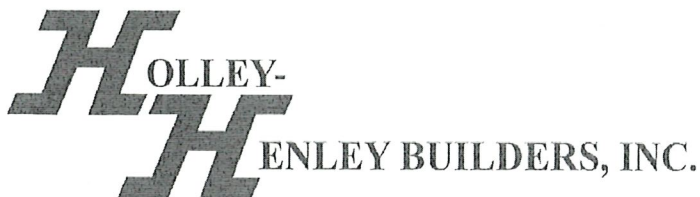
