

MINUTES OF THE LEE COUNTY COMMISSION, SPECIAL MEETING, NOV. 28, 2022

The Lee County Commission convened in a Special Meeting at the Courthouse in Opelika, Alabama, Monday, November 28, 2022 at 4:00 p.m. to discuss a matter of current litigation in executive session. The Chairman declared a quorum and officially opened the meeting with the following members recorded as being present: Judge Bill English, Chairman, and Commissioners Doug Cannon, Ross Morris, Gary Long and Tony Langley. Present via Zoom: Attorney Richard Davis and Jamie Frawley. Commissioner John Andrew Harris arrived approximately 15 minutes late.

Judge English opened the Special Meeting stating County Attorney Stan Martin indicated the following to remain in the chamber for the executive session in addition to the members of the Commission: Chief Administrative Officer Holly Leverette, County Engineer Justin Hardee and Chief Building Official and Interim Planning Director Joel Hubbard. Judge English stated the session is expected to last approximately 45 minutes and formal action is not anticipated at the conclusion.

After the conclusion of the Executive Session at approximately 4:40 p.m., Commissioner Cannon made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Morris to adjourn. The motion carried unanimously.
