

MINUTES OF THE LEE COUNTY COMMISSION, REGULAR TERM, NOV. 10, 2025

The Lee County Commission convened in regular session at the Courthouse in Opelika, Alabama, on Monday, Nov. 10, 2025, at 5:00 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited, followed by the invocation by Commissioner Cannon.

The Chairman declared a quorum and officially opened the meeting with the following members recorded as being present: Judge Jere Colley, Chairman, and Commissioners Doug Cannon, Ross Morris, Jeff Drury, Tony Langley, and Richard LaGrand.

John Sophocleus addressed the Commission and stated he was opposed to the county attorney recommendation.

Lance Farrar discussed concerns with the T.K. Davis Justice Center change order and issues with a current public records request on letters discussing fraudulent garbage billing.

Gary Smith thanked the Commission for the work it has done and stated he would let them know if they ever fail to work on behalf of the citizens.

Judge Colley recognized the elected officials in attendance: Revenue Commissioner Oline Price, Judge Mike Fellows, and Sheriff Jay Jones. There was no news media in attendance.

Commissioner Langley recognized the Beauregard Youth Football 6U, 8U, 10U and 12U teams for their accomplishments this football season with each team going undefeated. See attachment.

County Administrator Holly Leverette presented an update on the six ARPA Broadband projects that have been approved for Lee County. The update included each project's scope, current status and milestones achieved. See attachment.

Copies of the items on the Consent Agenda sent to the Commissioners in their packets included: listings of claims to be approved and ratified, procurement card transactions, and a copy of the minutes from October 27, 2025. Also included was a listing of additional Commissioner appropriations. As two names were presented for the Beulah Utilities Board, that item was moved to New Business for consideration. Commissioner Cannon made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Morris to approve the consent agenda. The motion carried unanimously. See attachment.

Commissioner Drury made a motion, seconded by Commissioner LaGrand, to approve the reappointment of Dr. Mike Hollingsworth to the Lee County Recreation Board (D3). The motion passed unanimously. See attachment.

BE IT RESOLVED, the Lee County Commission does hereby reappoint Dr. Mike Hollingsworth to the Lee County Recreation Board (D3) to serve a five-year term from October 14, 2025, until October 14, 2030.

Chief Operating Officer Blake Beck presented the results of the County Attorney Hiring

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Committee and recommended the hiring of Mrs. Robbie Hyde. Commissioner Morris made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Drury to approve the hiring of Mrs. Robbie Hyde as County Attorney. The motion carried on a 3-1-1 vote with Commissioner LaGrand voting no and Commissioner Cannon abstaining. See attachment.

Commissioner Langley stated two citizens were interested in the position on the Beulah Utilities Board. He then made a motion to advance Andrew Bryan for the first reading to the Beulah Utilities Board, seconded by Commissioner Drury. The motion passed unanimously. See attachment.

Mr. Beck presented a change order for the T.K. Davis Justice Center Renovation Project due to mold remediation issues discovered. Commissioner LaGrand made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Cannon to approve the T.K. Davis Justice Center Renovation Project Change Order. The motion carried unanimously. See attachment.

Mr. Beck presented the proposed 2026 Holiday and Meeting Schedule with adjustments to account for holidays, conferences and the organizational meeting. Commissioner Cannon made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Morris to approve the proposed 2026 Holiday and Meeting Schedule. The motion carried unanimously. See attachment.

Commissioner LaGrand requested to add an item to the agenda - increase in funding for Boys & Girls Club of Greater Lee County. Commissioner LaGrand made the motion which was seconded by Commissioner Cannon to add the item; the motion carried unanimously. Commissioner LaGrand then made a motion to increase the appropriation to the Boys & Girls Club by \$5,000 with the funds coming from his allocation. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Drury and carried unanimously.

At approximately 5:38 p.m., Commissioner LaGrand made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Cannon, to adjourn. The motion carried unanimously.

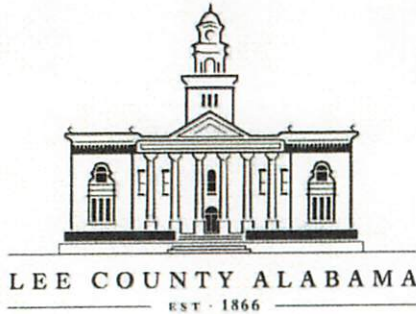

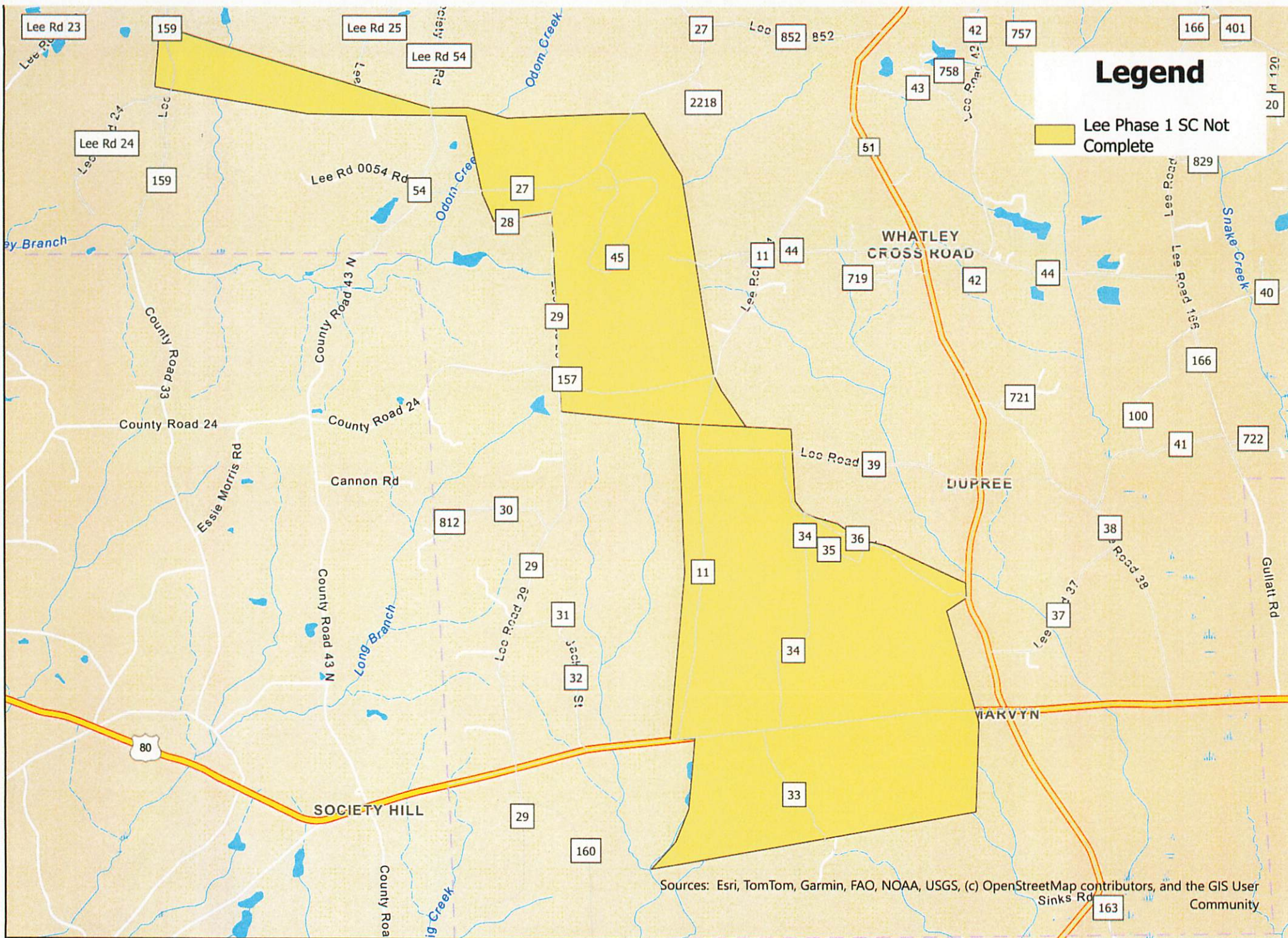

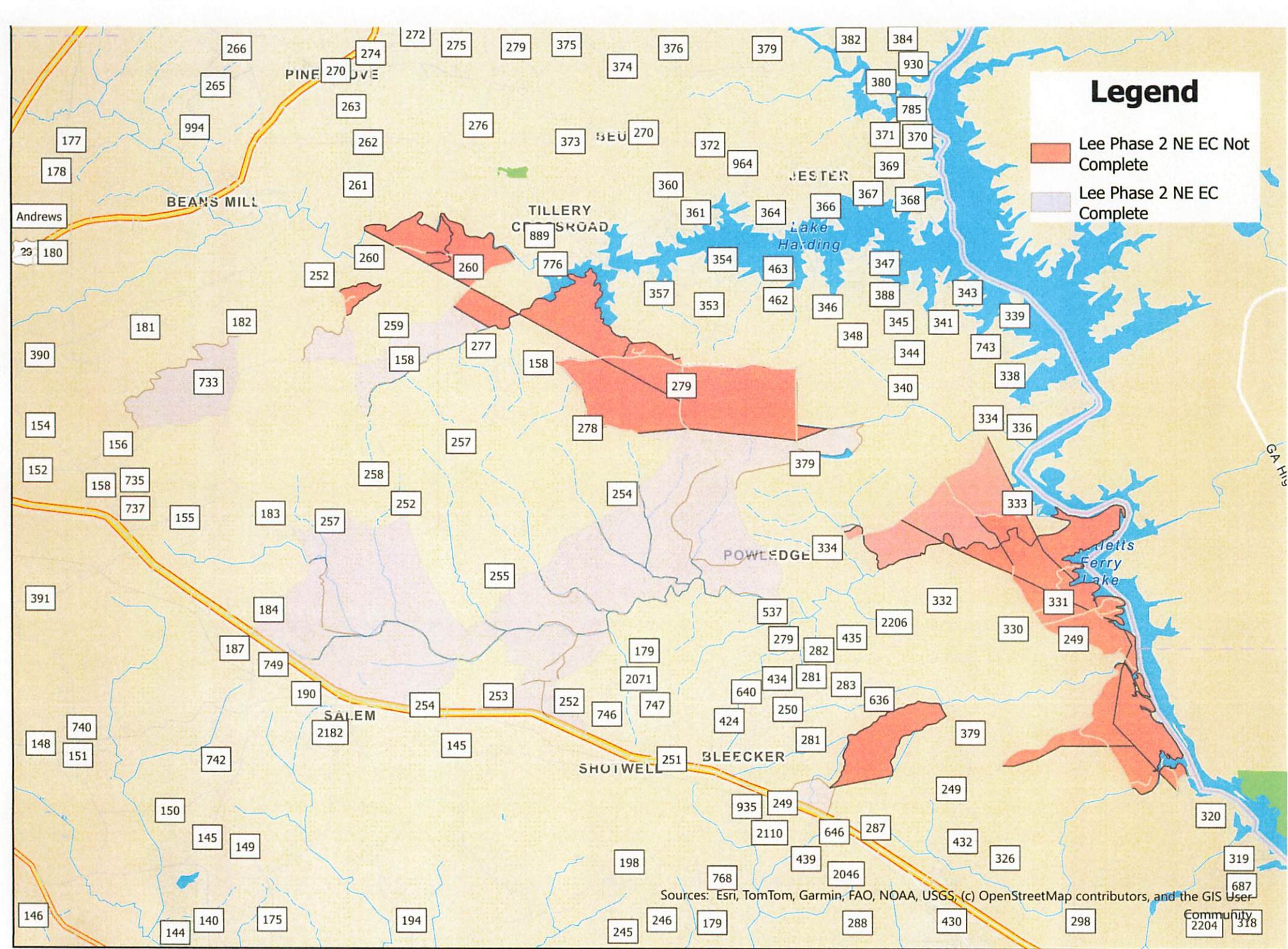
